



The Little Lads and Ladies of Virtue curriculum is essential to these lesson plans. You can use your own Bible, story Bible, videos, etc. However, due to copyright, I will only be referencing sections to complete in the curriculum, not actual content. See info at the bottom for additional resources mentioned. On Saturdays and Sundays, we spend time discussing their church class lessons.

Week One

Monday - Complete Day 1 on page 9, read 1 Samuel 3 and note Samuel's attentiveness, present the memory verse

Tuesday - Complete Day 1 on page 9, watch "A Voice in the Night" on app, practice memory verse

Wednesday - Complete Day 1 on page 9, watch "A Voice in the Night" on app, create motions/song to memory verse

Thursday - Complete Day 2 on page 10, have child read/retell 1 Samuel 3 narrative, recite verse together in ping-pong style (you say word, then child, then you, etc.)

Friday - Complete Day 2 on page 10, read Genesis 6:11-22 and note how Noah listened first to all instructions before he could obey them, present the verse

Week Two

Monday - Complete Day 2 on page 10, watch "Two by Two" on app, practice verse

Tuesday - Complete Day 3 on page 10, watch "Two by Two" on app, have child state verse alone

Wednesday - Complete Day 3 on page 10, read Exodus narrative noting Pharaoh's refusal to pay attention/listen, have child recite verse alone

Thursday - Complete Day 3 on page 10, watch "Let My People Go" on app, write each word of verse on index card and have child order cards (if age appropriate)

Friday - Complete Day 4 review section, do Role Play section, ask child to recite verse to a different person (via phone or in person)





Week Three

Monday - Complete Day 4 review section, play Attentiveness Game on page 11, ask child how God speaks today/where can we find His words? (In the Bible, His Word)

Tuesday - Complete Day 4 review section, play Attentiveness Game on page 11 (new tasks), ask child how God speaks today/where can we find His words? (In the Bible, His Word)

Wednesday - Play Mama Says on page 11, ask child how he/she can listen like Samuel to God's words

Thursday - Complete Day 5 on page 12, review how child can listen like Samuel to God's words, re-read I Samuel 3 and then discuss how child practiced Attentiveness

Friday - Complete Day 5 on page 12, have child teach a stuffed animal/action figure what he/she knows about Attentiveness

NOTES:

1. As you go along, show the child hints that you can give to remind them when they are or are not practicing attentiveness. This will allow you to correct with non-verbals in the future.
2. The child will most likely state how hard it is to pay attention/not get distracted. In addition to discussing practical tricks, do not miss the opportunity to point them to their greatest source of help, Jesus Christ. He never turns down a prayer for help from one of His own. This turned out to be a great opportunity to give my son the Gospel because he was acutely aware of his inability.
